We will begin to develop our writing skills. We will look at the elements needed to form a simple sentence such as the use of capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will continue to learn new phonics sounds and apply this to our reading. We will be using lots of stories to help us develop as writers such as “Little Red Riding Hood” and “The Gruffalo”.	In Maths, our focus will be on numbers up to 20. We will compare numbers using the language of more, less and fewer. We will order numbers by counting forwards and backwards. The children will also explore estimating groups of objects. We will also look at adding and subtracting using whole part models.	This half term, the children will be looking at plants. They will examine the different parts of plants and label these accordingly. They will also observe and record a range of plants in our school environment. The children will also be planting and caring for their own seeds.
